6. Philosophy / Geography / Music Vocal / Music Instrumental / Tabla / Rural Development / Agriculture Economics and Marketing / Industrial Economics / Travel and Tourism.

Note:

1. The candidates shall be allowed to offer both Hindi & Sanskrit as elective subjects from Group No. 1.
2. The candidates shall also be allowed to offer both Music (Vocal) & Music (Instrumental) as Elective Subjects from Group No. 6.
3. The combinations of Home Science with Computer Science as Elective subject is allowed.
4. The blind candidates shall be allowed to offer any two elective subjects out of Music (Vocal), Music (Instrumental) and Tabla from Group No. 6.
5. The candidates shall also be allowed to offer both Music (Vocal) & Tabla as Elective Subjects from Group No. 6.
6. A candidate may select Women Empowerment as an Elective Subject, which does not fall in any group.

VOCATIONAL SUBJECTS

Note: The candidate can choose one/two vocational subjects from the following groups, only one subject to be chosen from each group.

Note: 1. The Subject of 'Human Genetics' may be offered as an elective subject in combination with any other Life Sciences subject, with English, Punjabi and Chemistry being compulsory subjects.

Note: 2. Tourism & Hotel Management should not be taken along with Tourism and Travel Management.

Compulsory Course: The candidate shall be required to undertake the compulsory courses viz. Punjabi (Compulsory)/ Basic Punjabi/ Punjab History & Culture as per the provisions stated in the University Calendar Volume-II.

Discipline Specific Courses (DSCs): Each student is required to select three DSCs every year in their 3-year undergraduate degree program from the groups of combination of subjects. In the 4th year of undergraduate honours degree programme, student have the option to choose any one of the Discipline Specific Courses (DSCs) which they have studied during the first three years of their undergraduate degree programme. Provided that the opted Discipline Specific Courses (DSCs) is being offered by the University for the 4th year of the programme.
