- (d) Continuous wrap placket, two piece placket, kurta placket, darts- leg dart, fish  
dart, pleats- knife pleat, box pleat, inverted box pleat, gathers, tucks- pin tucks,  
space tucks, shell tucks, cord tucks.
- (e) Collars should be attached with bodice block: peter pan, cape, Chinese neck band  
collar.
- (f) Sleeves: plain, cap, and puff.
- (g) Pockets: side, patch, bound, kurta

- (b) A line frock/ gathered frock
- (c) Night suit.
